Southern California MAGA Members:

The Association's Championship Tournament returns to Palm Springs. Our headquarters will be at the Embassy Suites Hotel and Spa La Quinta 50-777 Santa Rosa Plaza, La Quinta, Ca. 92253. Rates are \$109.00 per night plus tax & resort fee. Reservations may be made by calling 1-760-777-1711. **Make sure you mention that you are part of The Southern California Mexican American Golf Association and give them our code SCM.** These rates apply until our allotted rooms are taken, you are encouraged to make your reservations as soon as possible. Only SC MAGA Members are entitled to the \$109.00 per night rate.

We will be playing Desert Willow Golf Resort. Desert Willow requires that we pay our fees in advance so we are asking all participants to make payment by the deadline so that we can guarantee our spots. You need to submit you entry early to guarantee a spot.

Two packages are being offered. The first package is \$275.00 and includes two rounds of golf with cart, tee gift, lunch both days, @ the course. The second package is \$325.00 and includes the same as above plus an extra dinner. Extra dinners will be \$50.00.

Check in & sign up for **gross skins and closest to the pins within each flight** (\$60.00 total for weekend), as well as tee gifts will be available on Friday evening from 7:00pm to 9:00pm. Please note: you may have someone else pick up your tee gift if you are unable to attend Friday. Their signature will be required to receive the gift.

Remember, to be eligible to compete for the Club Championship, a member must have played at least **four** tournaments as a member (with any chapter or combination of chapters) since last year's championship tournament. Those not meeting this requirement, including new members without an index will compete in the Callaway flight. A guest flight will be available provided we do not have a full field. Guest will pay an additional \$10.00. If you know anyone who wishes to participate, please have him or her contact your tournament chairman. May index will be used.

The proposed index breakdown for each flight will be as follows: A= 0–9.9; B= 10.0–15.6; C= 15.7–20.4; D= 20.5 and up, these are to be used as a guideline. Actual breakdowns will depend on actual # of entries. Men Blue Tees, Women Gold Tees.

The senior division (60 years and older) will also be available. However, if a senior wins in both the regular flight and in the senior division, only the higher of the two prizes will be awarded. **Seniors, please enter your age on the entry form.**

Any juniors (under 18 yrs. old) wishing to participate will be at a price of \$200.00 (Green Fees and Dinner only), as they will not be eligible to win prizes or receive a Tee gift, **please note this on your entry form.** The tournament committee is working with Desert Willow to reduce the Green Fees for Juniors.

<u>Please get your entries in early.</u> Trophies will be awarded to the winners. The association champion will be presented a red blazer and the over-all net champion a green blazer. Both of these champions will also have their entry paid for next year's championship tournament. <u>Each Flight Champion</u>, Gross and Net will have their green fees paid for next year's championship tournament.

In the event of a tie for the association gross or net championship or for any of the gross and net flights, a playoff will take place at that course immediately after the second round of play. All other ties will be determined
from the second round card-off. If a players that is tied leaves the course, he will forfeit his Flight
Championship. Should all tied players leave the course a match card(s) will determine the winner. Reminder, it
is the responsibility of the player to attest his scorecard and ensure that it is turned in to the tournament
committee.

The dress code will be enforced. No jeans, tank tops, or shirts without collars and no shorts shorter than six inches above the knees will be allowed. Soft spikes only will be allowed. Players are not allowed to bring their own alcoholic beverages to the course. This rule will be strictly enforced.

If you are planning on playing in this tournament, <u>you must send your entry to your chapter tournament</u> <u>chairman by, 24 April 2010.</u> I will be meeting with all chapter tournament chairmen on Saturday, 1 May 2010 at 9:00 a.m. Green River Golf Club to collect all entries. Practice rounds will be available. Contact Carlos Iglesias at 626 233-6923. He will be the only contact for practice rounds and a special rate. I hope to see everyone at this year's event.
