## **SC MAGA Members:**

The Association's Championship Tournament returns to Palm Springs. Our headquarters will be at the RIVIERA HOTEL 1600 N. Indian Canyon Dr. Palm Springs, Ca. 92262. Rates are \$159.00 for standard room and \$179.00 for Jr. Suite per night plus tax(Resort Fees will be waived at check in) Reservations may be made by calling (760)327-8311 or weblink:

https://www.starwoodmeeting.com/events/start.action?id=1610176680&key=24A9E7CC These rates apply until our allotted rooms are taken; deadline to make your reservations is **Apr. 22**<sup>th</sup>. Only SC MAGA Members are entitled to the \$159.00 and \$179.00 per night rate. You have 72 hours prior for cancellations.

## We will be playing Tahquitz Creek Golf Resort. Shotgun start at 7:30 am.

Entry Fee is \$235.00 and includes two rounds of golf with cart, range balls, tee gift, breakfast, lunch and two drinks. Also we have 62 spots available for a Fridays round if your chapter has a skin game, you will get the same deal as the Association Tournament (Green fees include: Breakfast, Lunch and 2 drinks w/range balls) Check in & sign up for gross skins and closest to the pins within each flight (\$70.00 total for weekend), as well as tee gifts will be available on Friday evening from 6:30pm to 8:30pm. (If you can't make it for check in on Friday, you can pay your Green fees and your Buy in together) Please note: You may have someone else pick up your tee gift if you are unable to attend Friday. Their signature will be required to receive the gift.

Remember, to be eligible to compete for the Club Championship, a member must have played at least **four** tournaments as a member (with any chapter or combination of chapters) as of June 1st 2016. Players not meeting this requirement, including new members without an index will compete in the Guest/Callaway flight. Guest will pay an additional \$10.00. If you know anyone who wishes to participate, please have them contact your tournament chairman. Handicaps will be based on your Lowest Index during the last three Months. (Feb. 1<sup>st</sup> thru May 1<sup>st</sup>)

The proposed index breakdown for each flight will be as follows: A=0-9.9; B=10.0-17.4; C=17.5-25.4; D=25.5 and up, these are to be used as a guideline. Actual breakdowns will depend on actual number of entries. A Flight Players will play from the Men's Blue Tees All other Flights: Men White Tees both days, Women Red Tees Both Courses. Only players in the A flight may win the overall Club Championship. If your index is higher than 9.9 and would like to play in the A flight, your index will be adjusted to 9.9. All flights will be eligible to win the Net Club Championship.

The senior division (60 years and older) will also be available. However, if a senior wins in both the regular flight and in the senior division, only the higher of the two prizes will be awarded. Seniors, please enter your age on the entry form.

All Junior Golfers (under 18 years of age) wishing to participate will be at a price of \$120.00 (Green Fees only), as they will not be eligible to win prizes or receive a Tee gift, **please note this on your entry form.** 

<u>Please get vour entries in early.</u> Gift cards and Framed Certificate will be awarded to the winners. The association champion will be presented a red blazer and the over-all net champion a green blazer. Both of these champions will also have their entry paid for next year's championship tournament. Each Flight Champion, Gross and Net will have their green fees paid for next year's championship tournament.

In the event of a tie for the association gross or net championship or for any of the gross and net flights, a playoff will take place at that course immediately after the second round of play. If a player that is tied leaves the
course, he will forfeit his Flight Championship. Should all tied players leave the course a match card(s) will
determine the winner. Reminder, it is the responsibility of the player to attest his scorecard and ensure that it is
turned in to the tournament committee.

The dress code will be enforced. No jeans, tank tops, or shirts without collars and no shorts shorter than six inches above the knees will be allowed. Soft spikes only will be allowed. Players are not allowed to bring their own alcoholic beverages to the course. This rule will be strictly enforced.

The foursomes will be by flight and mix chapters, if you would like to play with a partner from your same chapter he will have to be in the same flight, no exceptions. **Make the arrangements with your tournament chair person.** 

If you are planning on playing in this tournament, <u>you must send your entry to your chapter tournament chairman by, April 28, 2017.</u> I will be meeting with all chapter tournament chairmen on Saturday, April 29, 2017 at 9:00 a.m. Eagle Glen Golf Club to collect all entries. Practice rounds will be available. Call the course directly and mention that you are with SC MAGA. I hope to see everyone at this year's event.
